We also offer 251 ebooks for student and staff use and provide access to multiple databases for e-book reading. Our Book Room holds 4152 book collections for classroom use. Recently we have opened up our circulation to VM online students. All collections are searchable in our Media Center catalog, Destiny – accessible through Clever Portal.
